

Summer School Program with Fordham University

Call for Applications

For students of the Faculty of Law

1. General rules

- a. UER and Fordham University have a Joint Educational Partnership, that permits UER students to attend the <u>Fordham Law Summer School</u>
- b. Students will be considered for participation if they are currently enrolled in the 3rd, 4th or 5th year of the Integrated Master's Degree in Law (in the academic year 2024-2025) will be considered eligible to participate in the program.

c. The period of mobility will be 9 Jul- 25 Jul 2025.

- d. The students will continue to be registered and pay their regular fees at UER during their stay at Fordham Law Summer Institute.
- e. Selected students will self-cover expenditure relating to their participation in the program, notably Fordham Law Summer School's fees, transport, accommodation, food, administrative and personal expenses.
- f. Selected students will be granted a scholarship of €750. The total number of scholarships available for the Fordham Law Summer School 2025 Program is 3.

- g. Selected students will have to follow both universities' rules and conditions, as for attendance, deadlines, etc.
- h. The successful participation in the program, duly attested by the Fordham Law Summer Institute certificate, will grant students 6 ECTS recognized at UER as an elective course.

2. Eligibility and selection requirements

- a. The students' selection is made by an academic commission nominated by the Rector.
- b. Above-mentioned students will be considered eligible only if, within the a.y. 2024/2025 Fall examination session:
 - they will have passed and registered at least a total of:
 - **100** ECTS/CFU, if enrolled in the third year;
 - **150** ECTS/CFU, if enrolled in the fourth year;
 - **200** ECTS/CFU, if enrolled in the fifth year
 - They have a weighted **average** grade of/above **26/30**;
 - They have a minimum level B2 in the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages; also recognized TOEFL iBT minimum score 90, IELTS minimum score 6.5.

c. The selection follows a **two-step process**:

Step 1: Eligible candidates will be shortlisted considering their academic performance (credits and weighted average grade, counting 55% and 45% of the academic score, respectively), their proficiency in English, motivation letter, curriculum vitae or any recommendation letter.

Step 2: Fordham Law Summer Institute will receive from UER the list of candidates already evaluated by the commission with their dossier. Fordham University has the right to determine the final ranking after the analysis of the documentation previously transmitted.

3. Application Procedure

•

- a. The application deadline for participating in the selection process is the May 13th. Students will have to send the application form and all the required attachments (language certification, motivation letter, curriculum vitae or any recommendation letter) to <u>elena.lecci@unier.it</u> by that deadline.
- b. Students will be able to participate only if they have no pending administrative issues with Università Europea di Roma.

4. **Results' Publications**

- ^{a.} The selection results will be published on the UER website on May 14th.
- b. Students will be responsible for all procedures regarding application and <u>registration</u> to the Fordham Law Summer School.
